250 years ago, our nation's Founding Fathers had had enough with the tyranny of the British government, and the king specifically, who used the 13 colonies for what he could get out of them but withheld from them the Rights and Liberties accorded Englishmen in Britain.

The reasons for this severance were clearly spelled out in the Declaration of Independence, of which the following is an excerpt:

We hold these truths to be selfevident, that all men are created equal, that **they are endowed** by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights*, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness. That to secure these rights, Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed, That

whenever any Form of Government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the Right of the People to alter or to abolish it, and to institute new Government, laving its foundation on such principles and organizing

its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their Safety and Happiness. Prudence, indeed, will dictate that Governments long established should not be changed for light and transient causes; and accordingly all experience hath shewn, that mankind are more

disposed to suffer, while evils are sufferable, than to right themselves by abolishing the forms to which they are accustomed. But when a long train of abuses and usurpations, . . . it is their right, it is their duty, to throw off such Government, and to provide new Guards for their future security....

As you can see, our foundation was firmly built on the principle



that God created us, that He gave us fundamental rights just because we are His Creation, and government is organized to protect, not exploit those Rights. When it ceases to protect them, it A government big should be overthrown.
